L. R. “Robin” French is an active entrepreneur and investor, and has over 30 years of hands on management experience. Most recently, Mr. French founded and is co-owner of FEC Holdings, LP (FEC), the largest franchise of the Incredible Pizza Company (IPC). FEC is currently in the process of building IPC family entertainment centers (50,000 sq. ft.) in its franchise territory which extends from Arizona to Florida. In 2002, Mr. French became a significant shareholder and member of the board of managers of Waldo’s Dollar Mart, a growing \$350 million revenue per year dollar store company based in Mexico City. In 1995, Mr. French founded Arena Power Company, which developed independent power projects in Latin America and still owns and operates a power plant in Guatemala, and MCS Technologies, a leading energy waste management company that was acquired by U.S. Filter (a NYSE company). Prior to this, Mr. French was President of French Petroleum Corporation and affiliates, independent oil and gas companies that had significant operations in several of the major hydrocarbon basins in the United States. Over the course of several years, ending in 1994, Mr. French sold the majority of his oil and gas properties.
