- **Daytime and Post-Baccalaureate Limitations:** The BBA is exclusively a daytime program for students seeking their first undergraduate degree. Post-Baccalaureate (PB) students are not permitted to pursue undergraduate business coursework and should consult an advisor for other options.
- **TRANSFER EQUIVALENCY: Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS):** The TCCNS is the categorization system used by the State of Texas to identify standard lower-level core curriculum among Texas public colleges and universities, regardless of institution. Using this system and our web resources at www.bauer.uh.edu/prospective can assist students in more easily determining transfer course equivalency for core. If a TCCN is not listed, this means that there is no Texas Common Core equivalency available, although petitioning is an option in some cases. Consult an advisor for more information.
- **Business Minors:** Business majors and non-business students may pursue and declare business minors if certain requirements are met. Non-business students may pursue and declare all available business minors if they meet specific GPA, prerequisite, and credit hour requirements.
