After-Tax Deductions

Any other items withheld from your pay, such as additional insurance deductions or a University of Houston, such as the United Way contribution. These are deducted from your pay after Federal withholding, Medicare, and Social Security taxes are calculated.

Employer Paid Benefits

Shows the value of any benefits paid by the employer-paid portion of retirement or employer-paid portion of medical insurance costs.

TOTAL GROSS

** Federal Taxable Gross Total earnings subject to Federal withholding tax; it is Total Earnings minus your Before-Tax Deductions.

Net Pay Total Your Net Pay is your Gross Pay minus your Taxes, and Deductions. Net Pay is "Take Home" pay.

Leave Accrual/Fiscal Year

This indicates the hours of leave time (Compensatory Time, Vacation and Sick) accrued and used during the fiscal year.
