## FUNDING YOUR DEGREE



There are several different options available to help students fund their degree.

Apply to the MSACCY program early, and work closely with our scholarship and financial aid advisors to identify funding opportunities for your degree.

### FINANCIAL AID

- Financial aid is available to U.S. citizens and permanent residents through the federal government.
- An application is available through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid website, at <a href="https://www.studentaid.gov">www.studentaid.gov</a>. Complete your FAFSA as soon as possible after October 1 of the year you plan on attending.

## **INSTRUCTIONAL ASSISTANT POSITIONS**

- > An Instructional Assistant (IA) is a type of graduate assistant.
- > IAs are graduate students who do not have direct instructional duties but assist their employing departments with academic courses (ex. tutoring and grading), programs, or other activities in support of the instructional process.
- > Recipients of IA positions may be eligible for instate tuition waivers.
- > IA jobs are available through various departments in Bauer and other colleges.

### **GRANTS**

> Grants are available on a limited basis for Bauer graduate students.

### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

- Prospective students who meet certain requirements may be eligible for scholarships available through the university, college, or department.
- > Scholarships are available for both domestic and international students.
- > Eligibility requirements vary based upon scholarship criteria.
- > Some scholarships come with an in-state tuition waiver (if needed).
