HOW TO BECOME A REGISTERED ORGANIZATION ASSOCIATED WITH BAUER

It is recommended that students interested in forming a new student organization to meet with the Bauer Associate Director for Student Engagement for information about the process.

All new student organizations must first be registered with the UH Center for Student Involvement for two consecutive long semesters (Fall and Spring). It is recommended that students interested in forming a new student organization to meet with the Bauer Associate Director for Student Engagement for information about the process.

Once an organization has successfully been established for a year, the organization will meet with the Bauer Student Organization committee comprised of college staff; Program Manager, Director and a Representative of the Dean's Office for an initial proposal and review.

If the committee decides the student organization can move forward, the student organization will present at a Bauer Leaders' Council meeting and provide an opportunity for questions from the organizations at Bauer to provide their input to the Bauer Student Organization Committee.
